2017 GREATER LEXINGTON USBC OPEN TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Entry will be open only to sanctioned members of the Greater Lexington USBC in good standing. USBC rules will apply.
2. The tournament shall consist of a (5) person team event, doubles event, singles event and all events.
3. Entrants will use their highest 2015-16 Greater Lexington USBC yearbook average. If no yearbook average the entrant must use their highest current average in a Greater Lexington USBC sanctioned league with a minimum of 21 games by December 31, 2016. Entrants that do not meet either of these requirements will bowl scratch. Summer and Greater Lexington USBC Youth averages will be recognized per USBC rule #319a-1.
4. The tournament will be a handicap event. Handicap shall be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 230.
5. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to adjust any bowler's average prior to participation.
6. Bowlers may bowl as many times as they wish in the team event. However, no more than three players on the same team can place more than once in the prize list of position standings. Bowlers may bowl as many times as they wish in the doubles and singles events, but may only bowl once with the same partner. Singles only and doubles only competition are not permitted, bowlers must bowl in both events. Bowlers who bowl in multiple singles events may cash multiple times.
7. A bowler's first appearance in each event will count for their all events total. However, a bowler wishing to participate in all events must enter the all events prior to their first participation in the tournament.
8. The tournament WILL accept Walk-In entries. These will be accepted BASED UPON LANE AVAILABILITY! Walk-In entries must notify the Tournament Manager one hour prior to squad time and submit all necessary paperwork and required fees. Entries will close one hour prior to the last squad of the tournament.
9. The lineup will be the same as shown on the entry form. Substitutes will take the place of the original entrant. Entries will be scheduled per request if possible and in the order received. THE SCHEDULE WILL NOT BE CHANGED by the Tournament Manager except in the case of extreme emergency! Lanes will be assigned by the Tournament Manager for each event. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to reschedule a squad if there are not enough entries, or to add if needed. NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED! Prize money will be returned 100%. Ratio in prize money shall be one in seven entries.
10. In the Team event, team captains must check in the entire team one-half hour prior to squad time. Bowlers in doubles and singles will check in one-half hour prior to squad time.
11. The Board of Directors of the Greater Lexington USBC shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under the construction of these rules. Their decision will be final subject to USBC.
